RYTON TRIATHLON CLUB is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the wellbeing of all its members. The club believes that it is important that members, coaches, administrators and supporters associated with the club should, at all times, show respect, encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club with *ANY MEMBER OF THE CLUB COMMITTEE*.

- **As a member of *RYTON TRIATHLON CLUB*, you are expected to abide by the following club rules:**
- To abide by the Club Constitution
- To entrust the administration of my membership to the Committee
- All members must play within the rules and respect officials and their decisions.
- To encourage and commend fellow members in their training, competition and participation
- To encourage and commend fellow competitors, whether independent or members of other clubs.
- To provide details of all other sporting clubs of which you are a member and indicate for which club(s) you will compete and in which discipline
- To provide any details regarding previous expulsion from any sporting club, including the reasons for such expulsion and any resulting suspensions from competition
- Where joining mid-season immediately from another club, to provide copies of your formal notice of resignations from that club
- To complete the club application form, declaring that the information entered thereon is correct to the best of your belief and knowledge
- To advise the Management Committee of any reason why you would not be eligible to train with or coach (where applicable) junior members under the rules and regulations of the sporting bodies to which the club is affiliated
- Members should keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform their coach or team manager if they are going to be late.
- Members must wear suitable kit – for training and events, as agreed with the coach/team manager.
- Members must pay any fees for training or events promptly.
- Members are not allowed to smoke on club premises or whilst representing the club at competitions.
- Members are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on the club premises or whilst representing the club.
